

Host Team Volunteers

Host Team committee volunteers act as a resource to construction volunteers on the build site. They are responsible for making sure volunteers have a great experience throughout the volunteer process.

Duties include:

- 1) Putting up signs
- 2) Setting up/Breaking down host tent
- 3) Setting up/tearing down and cleaning the table for breakfast and lunch
- 4) Assisting volunteers with signing in on the iPad
- 5) Help register volunteers who have not done so before
- 6) Locating the First Aid Kit
- 7) Distribute waters to the volunteers
- 8) Taking photos
- 9) Serving breakfast and lunch
- 10) Assure site is and stays clean
- 11) Act as a Habitat representative
- 12) Give out Habitat information

Anyone ages 14 or above is welcome to participate as a host volunteer. However it is important to note, our age limit to actively participate in construction on the site is 16. Due to the nature of the work we do, the liability is too great to allow for younger volunteers.
