Sponsorship Levels



Habitat-North Central Georgia is a nonprofit, Christian affordable housing ministry that builds affordable homes for purchase and performs critical home repairs for hardworking, low-income families in North Fulton, Forsyth, Cherokee, and Dawson Counties. Habitat keeps costs low for families by using volunteer labor and offering interest-free mortgages

Habitat-NCG programs are open to all people, regardless of race, religion, color, or creed.

House Sponsorships

House sponsorships help defray the costs of land acquisition, development, and house construction. A full house sponsorship is \$140,000, but most house sponsors fund a partial sponsorship, starting at \$5,000.



House sponsors usually provide teams of volunteers. Each Habitat-NCG build takes 12-14 weeks, 10 of which require volunteers. Most sponsors prefer Saturday build days, but some weekday volunteer days are available.

Home Repair Program Sponsorships

Our Home Repair Program assists income-eligible seniors, veterans, and disabled non-Habitat homeowners. We perform repairs ranging from exterior repairs such as siding replacement, painting, and landscape clean- up to critical repairs such as HVAC, roof, window, and deck replacement. Sponsorship opportunities starting at \$1,000 are available. Volunteer opportunities are available during the week and on Saturdays. Some projects do not allow volunteers due to the scope of work.

Master Builder Sponsor—\$140,000+

Multi-house sponsorship with the opportunity to bring up to 20 volunteers every volunteer build day on one or more build sites. Exclusive sponsorship recognition.

Builder Sponsor—\$100,000 - \$140,000

Full house sponsorship with the opportunity to bring up to 20 volunteers every volunteer build day. Exclusive sponsorship recognition.

Hammer Sponsor — \$40,000 — \$99,999

Opportunity to bring up to 20 volunteers on at least 5 build days. Logo used in all recognition.

Carpenter Sponsor — \$20,000 — \$39,999

Opportunity to bring up to 20 volunteers on 2-3 build days. Logo used in all recognition.

Foundation Sponsor—\$10,000—\$19,999

Opportunity to bring up to 15 volunteers on at least 1 day

Build Day Sponsor—\$5,000—\$9,999

Opportunity to bring up to 10-15 volunteers on 1 build day

Home Repair Sponsor—\$1,000—\$25,000

Opportunity to bring 5-15 volunteers on at least 1-3 repair build day.



Sponsorship Expectations

- Donate sponsorship funds at least 30 days prior to the First Nail Ceremony.
- Ensure that volunteers register & complete a Volunteer Release & Waiver prior to the build day.
- Provide a primary contact to serve as a liaison with Habitat-NCG.
- Provide the agreed number of volunteers each designated build day.
- Provide lunches & water for the sponsors' volunteers, Habitat- NCG staff, & partner family.
- Follow all safety rules and all instructions on the build site.
